This document provides information on the material currently used for LiveU product packaging.







Some of our packaging materials are marked by printing. Others are not marked to reduce the environmental impact or for technical reasons.

This guide covers both marked and unmarked packaging materials.

### 3. LiveU product packages

Packaging material used in standard product packaging	Examples	Material type	Recycling symbol
<b>Corrugated board</b> Boxes and similar. Most are marked.		Corrugated Board	 PAP
<b>Foam – LDPE</b> Sometimes used as filling material.		LDPE	 LDPE
<b>Sponges – LDPE</b> Sometimes used as filling material. Most are not marked		LDPE	 LDPE
<b>Nylon bags – LDPE</b> Sometimes used as filling material. Most are marked.		LDPE	 LDPE

<b>Pallet shrink wrap – LDPE</b> Used to wrap pallets of boxes. Not marked.		LDPE	
<b>Air filled cushions – LDPE (filling material)</b> Sometimes used as filling material.		LDPE	
<b>Bubble wrap – LDPE</b> Sometimes used as filling material.		LDPE	
<b>Anti-static bubble bags – LDPE</b> Sometimes used as filling material.		LDPE	

**Abbreviations:**

PE – Polyethylene

HDPE – High density polyethylene

LDPE – Low density polyethylene
